We Read Together and the 100 Black Men of South Metro, Inc.

Early childhood literacy is one way of minimizing the possibility of homelessness in a child's future. Getting the right start with literacy increases life chances, improves self-confidence and provides exposure beyond the limits of one's economic status.



We Read Together Program partners with community organizations, senior citizens and local businesses to provide volunteer reading coaches for 2nd and 3rd grade students.

We have mentored over 200 children in Fulton County Schools and now expanded to Clayton County Schools.

Unfortunately, due to COVID 19, we ended our program early this year to ensure everyone's safety.

However, we will continue our We Read Together program through a digital platform, starting June 11, 2020.

The summer session will be offered to the 2nd grade classes of Miles and Harper Archer Elementary Schools. I thank all of our partners and supporters for helping us change the lives of young people through literacy.
